
Dear Friend of Flow,

During the last eleven days in May, I had the opportunity to combine visits to flowmeter companies and oil fields with a tour of the Great Lakes. I especially remember the Pictured Rocks



tour along the edge of Lake Superior. I also took the opportunity to sample the whitefish from the Lakes. And the last day of my trip, I visited some oil and gas wells in Michigan. I am trying to better understand the drilling process, and find out first-hand what types of flowmeters are used. I found a large number of differential pressure and turbine flowmeters installed in these fields

- Oil & gas production, exploration, & distribution
- Refining & Petrochemical
- Power & Renewables
- Heating & Cooling
